CADPHF Lockdown Online Activities from April to July 2020

CADPHF free Tele -counseling support

Since April 2020 CADPHF team along with other volunteer Psychologists are offering free online tele- counseling support to adults, youths and parental guidance for children effected by the lockdown. CADPHF has also collaborated with Dr Ayesha Sarwat Child Psychiatrist at Dow Medical University for free psychological support for severely disturbed individuals.

CADPHF Ramadan online class for kids and Eid special activities

Around 200 children attended 15 days Ramadan online classes for 3-5 year olds conducted on zoom. The kids were introduced to basic Arabic letters and vocabulary along with Islamic poems. Special Daily Ramadan show and Eid activities were organized on our Facebook page for children to enjoy these blessed auspicious occasion during this challenge time.

CADPHF online Summer Learning for kids

Since June 2020 CADPHF has launched Summer Online Learning programme for Pre-schoolers (age 3-6) and Primary school children age (7-12 years) the programme is conducted on zoom from Monday to Friday and children are engaged in literacy, numeracy and STEAM activities on various themes and concepts.

CADPHF Virtual Summer Camps

In order to keep children engaged in creative fun learning activities CADPHF has offered various camps and short courses since June 2020 including online Virtual Summer Camp, Space Camp and Water Color painting classes for Children and Youths. The classes are conducted daily on Zoom and children have been provided with an art resource pack with material for creative activities.

CADPHF Free Basic Psychology Short Course

Due to the popularity and high demand of the field of Psychology, CADPHF conducted a six weeks Basic Psychology short course for youths ages 15-18 years who are interested in perusing a career in psychology. Special guests speakers Dr. Samia Ali from Univeristy of Karachi and MS Naima Sharif from Bahira University guided the participants and responded to the queries related to the admission criteria and scope for studying psychology in Pakistan.

CADPHF Free online creative activities for kids and family

CADPHF arranged special online free activities on our Facebook group to keep both children and adults engaged in fun learning activities, special weekly quiz shows with sponsored gift hampers, Quran journaling and recycled art and craft activities for children and adults.

CADPHF Collaborative research with university of Leicester and University of Toronto

CADPHF is currently participating in two international research projects. University of Leicester research aims to investigate the use and scope of free digital online child psychology course in Pakistan.

Univeristy of Toronto research with the department of Speech and Language pathology aims to investigate the development of language skills in 6 to 7-year-old Pakistani school children.

CADPHF Online Child Psychology Short Courses in collaboration with University of Leicester

40 participants registered for Child Psychology short course. Participants from all over the globe including Africa, Middle East, interior Sindh and Northern areas of Skardu and the beautiful valley of Hunza in Pakistan have joined this 10 module course.

CADPHF arranged weekly free awareness workshops and online session for psychological support to deal with lockdown anxiety

CADPHF Free online mindfulness and relaxation session for adults

CADPHF is conducting weekly free online mindfulness art sessions on our Facebook group

Online Research Seminar with University of Leicester

An online research training session was conducted by Professor Panos Vostanis and Dr. Michelle O Reilly from University of Leicester. The seminar explored research opportunities for future projects in Pakistan.

Positive Psychology Short Course

15 participants have joined six weeks short course on developing positive psychology skills during these challenging times.
